Corrective Services NSW COVID-Safe in-person visits

Roadmap to our new normal



STEP 1

Social in-person visits

Can be booked from 18 November 2020.
All visits must be pre booked. No walk-in visits will be allowed.
Reduced number of visit times available to allow for physical distancing.

Safety measures

- 2 visitors (including children, this means two adults or one child and one adult) per inmate
- A fist bump or elbow bump at the beginning and end of the visit is allowed but inmates and visitors must maintain physical distance at all other times
- Inmate and visitors must wear masks
- Temperature check and screening criteria will apply to visitors
- Maximum 30 minute visit

Video visits

Continue to be available.
We encourage visitors to use video visits as their first choice to help minimise the risks for everybody.

STEP 2

Social in-person visits

Booking date to be confirmed.
All visits must be pre booked. No walk-in visits will be allowed.
Reduced number of visit times available to allow for physical distancing.

Safety measures

- 4 visitors per inmate (e.g. one adult and three children)
- A brief hug at the beginning and end of the visit is allowed but inmates and visitors must maintain physical distance at all other times
- Inmate and visitors must wear masks
- Temperature check and screening criteria will apply to visitors
- Visits may run for up to 45 minutes

Video visits

Continue to be available.
We encourage visitors to use video visits as their first choice to help minimise the risks for everybody.

STEP 3

Social in-person visits

Booking date to be confirmed.
All visits must be pre booked. No walk-in visits will be allowed.
Reduced number of visit times available to allow for physical distancing.

Safety measures

- 4 visitors (plus children) per inmate
- Normal contact policies apply
- Screening criteria will apply to visitors
- Visits may run for up to an hour

Video visits

Continue to be available.
We encourage visitors to use video visits as their first choice to help minimise the risks for everybody.

Corrective Services NSW is continuously monitoring the situation and the advice of NSW Health.

NOTE: Visit information may change at any moment should a risk of COVID-19 be identified.
