

PRISONS ACT 1952 - PROCLAMATION

(L.S.) P.R. SINCLAIR, GOVERNOR

I, REAR ADMIRAL PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of the provisions of sections 5(3) and 5(5) of the Prisons Act 1952, do, by this Proclamation, declare the area comprised within the boundaries hereunder (together with all buildings or premises which are now or may hereafter be erected thereon) to be a prison within the meaning of the Prisons Act 1952, and I further declare that the prison shall be known as the Junee Correctional Centre, viz.:

All that piece or parcel of land situate in the Shire of Junee, Parish of South Junee and County of Clarendon being part of lots 1 and 2 Deposited Plan 703393: Commencing at a fence angle bearing 101 degrees 05 minutes 50 seconds 417.18 metres from the northwestern corner of the said lot 1; and bounded thence on the north, northeast generally southeast, generally southwest and generally northwest by manproof fenced lines bearing 90 degrees 306.42 metres, 142 degrees 21 minutes 3.02 metres, 195 degrees 05 minutes 224.54 metres, 105 degrees 12 minutes 7.09 metres, 195 degrees 07 minutes 6 metres, 285 degrees 19 minutes 7.09 metres, 195 degrees 05 minutes 224.61 metres, 247 degrees 09 minutes 2.96 metres, 300 degrees 09 minutes 50 seconds 306.45 metres, 337 degrees 47 minutes 2.92 metres, 15 degrees 04 minutes 40 seconds 294.63 metres and 51 degrees 59 minutes 2.94 metres to the point of commencement and having an area of 11.38 hectares or thereabouts.

I, Rear Admiral PETER ROSS SINCLAIR, A.C., Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council and pursuant to the provisions of section 5 (1) and 5 (2) of the Prisons Act 1952, do, by this Proclamation, declare the area comprised within the boundaries hereunder (together with all buildings or premises which are now or may hereafter be erected thereon) to be a prison complex within the meaning of the Prisons Act 1952, and I further declare that the prison complex shall be known as the Junee Correctional Complex, viz.:

All that piece or parcel of land situate in the Shire of Junee, Parish of South Junee and County of Clarendon, being Lot 2, Deposited Plan 593746, Lots 1 and 2, Deposited Plan 703393 and Lots 5 and 6, Deposited Plan 111285 and having an area of 108.1 hectares or thereabouts and said to be in the possession of Her Most Gracious Majesty Queen Elizabeth II (Minister for Corrective Services).
